



COSBURN PARK LAWN BOWLING CLUB SUBSIDIES POLICY

(Approved by the Board September 13, 2022)

Cosburn Park Lawn Bowling Club (CPLBC) provides financial subsidies to members competing in the Ontario Lawn Bowls Association (OLBA) and Bowls Canada Boulingrin (BCB) championship events based on all of the following criteria:

- 1) the member is a full member of CPLBC (OLBA fee paid to CPLBC)
- 2) full members who finish first (the "A" team) to advance out of District 10 to Provincials and/or first or second in Provincial competitions to advance to National championships
- 3) full members who finish first or second in Provincial Fours, Pairs, Mixed Pairs, or Seniors, or finish top four in the Provincial Singles, to advance to the Nationals
- 4) full members who registered at CPLBC prior to registering in the District competition in the year in which the Championship takes place
- 5) by accepting any subsidy amounts, such members agree to have their name(s) published by the Club
- 6) the subsidy is a one-time payment per event, per member
- 7) associate members (OLBA fee paid to another Club) do not receive a subsidy even if they play on a team representing CPLBC.

The subsidy paid to each eligible member will be based on the location of the event as follows:

Events in the GTA	= \$100
Events in Ontario, outside the GTA	= \$150
Events in the rest of Canada	= \$250

Notwithstanding any of the above:

- a) in situations it deems appropriate or necessary, the Board may authorize payment of a Special Subsidy to any member and/or a team from CPLBC competing in an OLBA or BCB championship event. The amount of this Special Subsidy shall not exceed two times the annual regular membership fees currently in effect, and shall be limited to one payment per member, per competition year.
- b) payment of any subsidies shall be predicated on the financial position of the Club as may be determined by the Board.

In the interest of time, the Competition Chair (or person(s) performing those duties) may submit the names of eligible subsidy recipients to the Executive for ratification by the Board.

The Board shall undertake to review the CPLBC Subsidies Policy and payout amounts on an annual basis.
